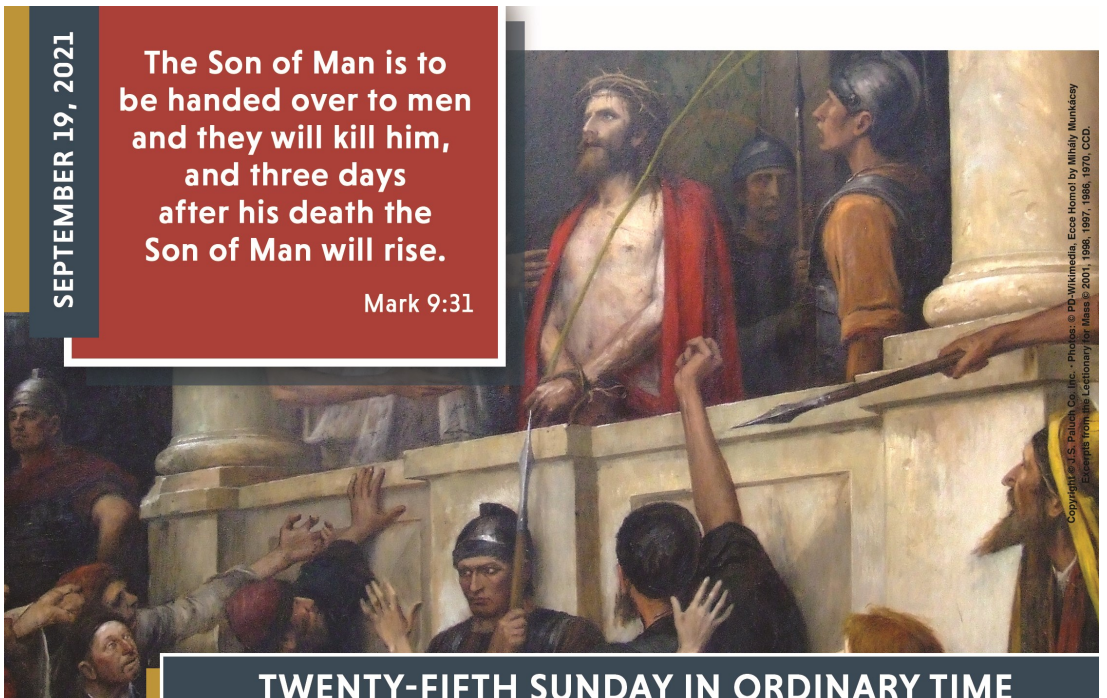

FROM THE PASTOR

WISDOM , IS A GIFT FROM GOD

Today's three Readings have one common denominator. They all speak of wisdom.

During the First Reading, [Wis. 2:12, 17-20] we heard prophetic words of the evil plans of the godless ones. They waited for the righteous one, the Lord Jesus, to test Him with insults and torture to find out how gentle He was. Because He made their lives inconvenient, opposed their actions and reproached them of their sins against the law, they planned to condemn Him to a shameful death.

While the godless ones applied human wisdom in the planning of their evil deeds, they failed to realize that human knowledge and understanding cannot compete against the Wisdom of God. For "The wisdom of this world is foolishness with God." [1 Cor. 3:19] "God's foolishness is wiser than human wisdom, and God's weakness is stronger than human strength." [1 Cor. 1:25] "

But what about spiritual wisdom? Does one have to attend school to learn it? On that subject, St. Paul says, "To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. To one is given through the Spirit the utterance of wisdom, and to another the utterance of knowledge according to the same Spirit." [1 Cor. 12:8]

Spiritual wisdom is a gift of the Holy Spirit. Spiritual knowledge and understanding cannot be obtained unless one is enlightened by the Holy Spirit by the grace of God the Father. "For the Lord gives wisdom; from his mouth comes knowledge and understanding; he stores up sound wisdom for the upright." [Prov. 2:6-7]

Human wisdom leads to sin. You want something and do not have it, so you commit murder. You covet something and cannot obtain it; so you engage in disputes and conflicts.

Spiritual wisdom leads to holiness. It is pure and from above. It is peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without a trace of partiality of hypocrisy.

During today's Gospel Reading, [Mk. 9:30-7] we heard that when Jesus was teaching the disciples, He told them that the Son of Man was to be betrayed into human hands, that they would kill Him and three days later,

SABIDURIA, COMO REGALO DE DIOS

Las tres lecturas de hoy tienen un denominador común. Todos hablan de sabiduría. Durante la Primera Lectura, [Sab. 2:12, 17-20] escuchamos palabras proféticas de los malos planes de los impíos. Esperaron a que el justo, el Señor Jesús, lo probara con insultos y torturas para descubrir cuán gentil era. Debido a que Él hizo sus vidas inconvenientes, se opuso a sus acciones y les reprochó sus pecados contra la ley, planearon condenarlo a una muerte vergonzosa.

Mientras que los impíos aplicaron la sabiduría humana en la planificación de sus malas acciones, no se dieron cuenta de que el conocimiento y la comprensión humanos no pueden competir contra la Sabiduría de Dios. Porque "La sabiduría de este mundo es necedad con Dios". [1 Corintios 3:19] "La necedad de Dios es más sabia que la sabiduría humana, y la debilidad de Dios es más fuerte que la fuerza humana". [1 Corintios 1:25] "La sabiduría espiritual es un don del Espíritu Santo. El conocimiento espiritual y la comprensión no se pueden obtener a menos que uno sea iluminado por el Espíritu Santo por la gracia de Dios el Padre. "Porque el Señor da sabiduría; de su boca sale el conocimiento y la comprensión; almacena sabiduría sólida para los rectos". [Prov. 2:6-7].

La sabiduría humana conduce al pecado. Quieres algo y no lo tienes, así que cometes un asesinato. Codicias algo y no puedes obtenerlo; por lo que te involucras en disputas y conflictos. La sabiduría espiritual conduce a la santidad. Es puro y de arriba. Es pacífica, gentil, dispuesta a ceder, llena de misericordia y buenos frutos, sin rastro de parcialidad de hipocresía. Durante la lectura del Evangelio de hoy, [Mc 9:30-7] escuchamos que cuando Jesús estaba enseñando a los discípulos, les dijo que el Hijo del Hombre debía ser traicionado en manos humanas, que lo matarían y tres días después, Él resucitaría. Los discípulos no entendían de lo que Jesús estaba hablando. ¿Por qué?

Porque su sabiduría humana no tenía el conocimiento y la comprensión necesarios para percibir de lo que Jesús estaba hablando. Tampoco su sabiduría espiritual tenía el conocimiento y la comprensión para percibir la muerte y resurrección del Señor que se acercaba rápidamente. Estas palabras tenían que ser pronunciadas para que fueran entendidas en un momento posterior cuando Jesús dijera: "Estas son mis palabras que les hablé mientras todavía estaba con ustedes: que todo lo escrito sobre mí en la ley de Moisés, los profetas y los salmos

He would rise again. The disciples did not understand what Jesus was talking about. Why?

Because their human wisdom did not have the necessary knowledge and understanding to perceive what Jesus was talking about. Nor did their spiritual wisdom have the knowledge and understanding to perceive the death and resurrection of the Lord that was quickly approaching. These words had to be spoken so they would be understood at a later time when Jesus would say, "These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you - that everything written about me in the law of Moses, the prophets, and the psalms must be fulfilled." Then he opened their minds to understand the scriptures

Why does God bless His children with pure wisdom? In a few words, it is to bless us with Divine love and grace, the Lord God wanting to share His eternal glory with those who ask for the spiritual gift of wisdom.

In greater details, the Divine Wisdom of God serves the following purposes:

- 1) Revealing the Divine characteristics of God to His children;
- 2) Revealing the Divine Plan of redemption to mankind;
- 3) Revealing His Divine Will to each and every one of us;
- 4) Revealing His Divine mysteries to each and every one of us;
- 5) Revealing His only Begotten Son Jesus Christ to the world;

As can be perceived from this list, there are many benefits to be gained through Divine Wisdom. The gift of wisdom provides us with an understanding of the Word of knowledge. It helps us to perceive God's guidance. It unravels the Holy Bible parables that hold the key to righteous living, eternal life and salvation.

By the grace of the heavenly Father, we are able to perceive spiritual knowledge. Through the indwelling of the Holy Spirit, the Words of Our Lord Jesus unravel themselves in our spiritual minds. The gift of wisdom is necessary for us to grow in the love of Jesus.
